

ATM MEETING MINUTES - April 10, 2018

1. Opening Meditation: Bill shared a reading from Pope Francis
2. Revised ATM Mission Statement: ***“To be the presence of Christ with our brothers and sisters of Holy Family Parish, building supportive relationships throughout the community.”***
3. Father Jugene’s visit: May 12-13
 - Need ATM members to participate in meals with Father Jugene: Saturday dinner, Sunday lunch and dinner.
 - Still need volunteers to man the ATM tables at all masses that weekend
 - Funds will be collected for Father and Holy Family Parrish in the second collections at all Masses

4. Gina ordered new, professional three wing mobile display panel. This will be an excellent tool to display our ATM work.
5. Father Jugene working diligently to make the four churches one parish and reviewing the financial records of each church.
6. New Funding request approved by committee members:
 - \$6,000 for Center for Christian Action
 - \$3,500 for Teen Venture
 - Challenge to organize ATM main fund raising event spring of next year.
7. Members agreed to go back to monthly meetings. Next meeting will be May 8th.
8. Kathleen suggested involving our teens in fund raising. Possibly offer them a percentage of donations. Also could attract teens’ parents to join our ATM ministry.
9. Status review:
 - Shirley offered thanks for donations of cards and stamps for liaison ministry.
 - Need volunteers for RAM in October. Need to start securing hotel rooms.
 - Holy Family Parish has started their own prayer shawl ministry.
 - \$7,000 sent to HFP to support backpack program and pantries. Our Teen Life students raised this money!
10. Mark suggested having a summer outing with all four churches. Great way to build relationship with HFP members. (Contact: Donna Lambert, St. Elizabeth)
11. Bill’s daughter has several hundred books she would like to donate to the parish. Liaisons will check with respective HFP churches and teen center to gauge interest. Questions regarding storage of books and delivery to Appalachia.
12. Discussed date for back to school supplies. Avoid St Elizabeth Jazz Festival weekend. Check about tax free weekend and allow time to deliver cards to HFP.
