

Kindergarten Faith Formation

Eligibility: Involved in Kindergarten learning beginning this fall.

Classes: Will be offered during the 9:15am and 11:15am Sunday Masses. [Complete calendars are available on the website.](#) Children will begin in the classroom with a catechist and will join you in Mass at about the time of the Prayers of the Faithful.

Up to 13 children per classroom with one volunteer catechist and a parent volunteer each week. ***Parents are expected to volunteer in the classroom on a rotating basis, unless a member of your family is serving as a preschool or kindergarten catechist.***

Every class will have two catechists assigned to it. The catechists will teach the first and final class together and will rotate leading the class during the other weeks with a parent volunteer for the safety of the children.



Curriculum:

We are continuing with the Pflaum "Gospel Weeklies" program. Children will enjoy learning about the weekly Gospel in this lectionary-based program. [See an online preview.](#)
